

Empowering Youth for the Future of Work: International Project Meeting Held in Lithuania

On September 27, 2024, the second transnational meeting of the “Developing Youth Skills for Industry 4.0 in the Age of Robotic and Digital Smart Production” project was held in Panevėžys, Lithuania, hosted by the Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce, Industry, and Crafts. The meeting brought together project partners from Lithuania, Türkiye, and France.



The first session featured a presentation by ERFEY (Türkiye), the leader of Activity-2. ERFEY introduced a training module design that includes both theoretical and practical components. Partners discussed the content and suggested improvements. ERFEY agreed to update the content templates and produce instructional videos for the theoretical parts. These updates will be reviewed at the next online meeting on November 13, 2024.

In the second session, the project’s coordination and dissemination efforts were reviewed. Each partner was reminded of their responsibilities. An online evaluation questionnaire prepared by Hexagonale (France) will be completed by all partners by October 11, 2024.

Following this meeting, the training content has been finalized in draft form. Each partner will organize a national workshop with 15 participants from the target group to pilot the training in their own country.

The final summit of the project will take place on June 19, 2025, from 10:00 to 13:00 at Gaziosmanpaşa Vocational High School in Istanbul, Türkiye. Hosted by the Gaziosmanpaşa Chamber of Tradesmen and Craftsmen and led by the Turkish partner ERFEY, the event will bring together young participants and representatives from the industrial sector across Europe.
